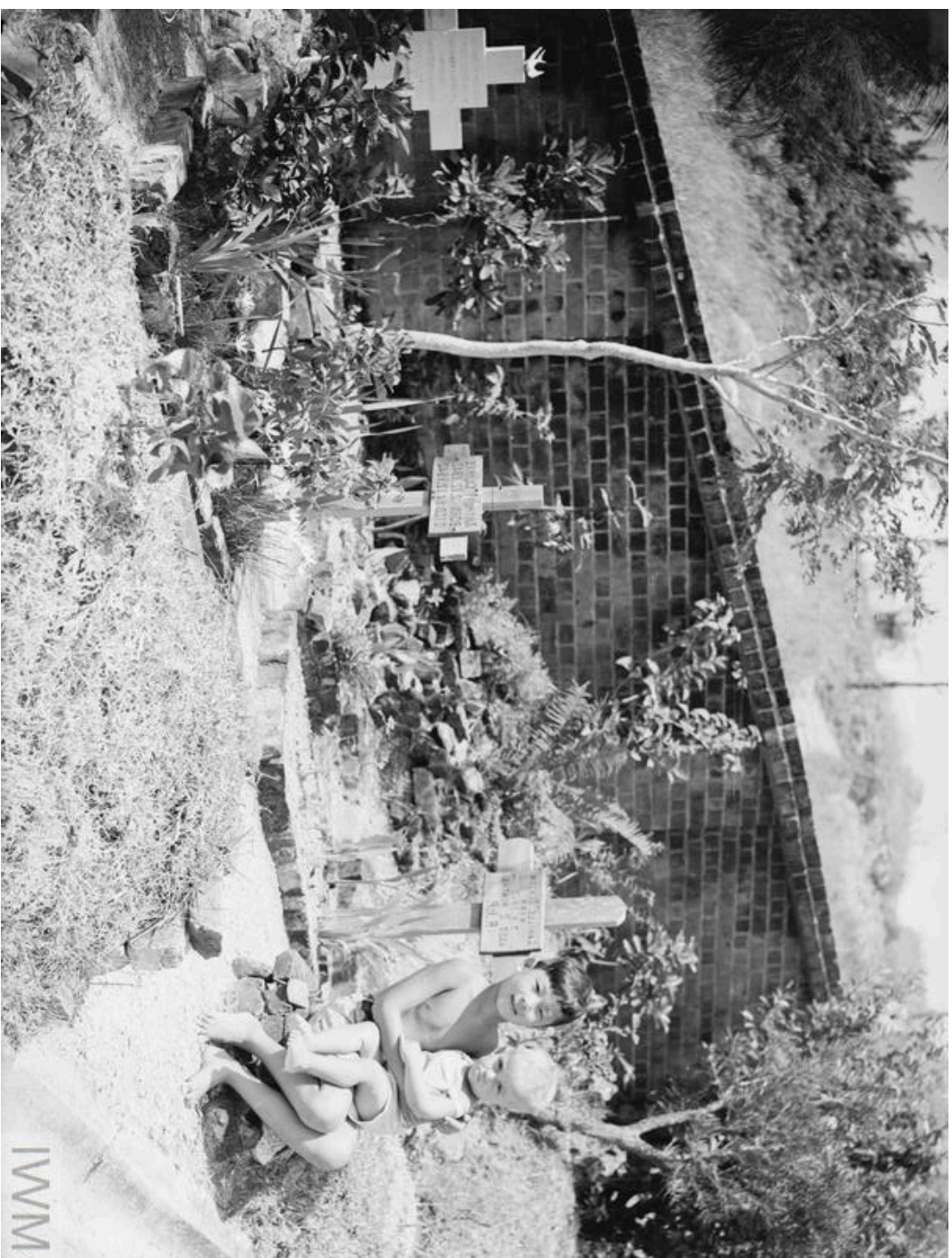
What doesn't this source tell me?

What does this source tell me?



Children died from hunger in the Stanley Internment camps

There was a section of the cemetery at the internment camp that was dedicated for children

Living conditions in the camps were poor

Eurasian children were not evacuated to safety in the war like their European peers

Children were underfed in the internment camps

Other aspects of their war experience beyond food, such as education

Did these children's parents try to evacuate them to escape being interned by Japanese troops? Were they blocked from this by the white Australian policy as others were?
